USHCC to Support American Debut of Europe's Largest Cybersecurity Conference in San Antonio, the American Hub of Cybersecurity Innovation, in June 2025

WASHINGTON - January 15, 2025 – The United States Hispanic Chamber of Commerce, America's largest Hispanic business advocacy group, announced today a strategic partnership with the InCyber Forum to support its first-ever U.S.-based conference, to be held **June 17-18, 2025, in San Antonio, Texas**. The InCyber Forum is the host of Europe's largest annual multi-day cybersecurity conference, which, since 2007, has become the preeminent cybersecurity convening in Europe focused on digital security and trust. The forum goes beyond the traditional trade show, bringing together public- and private-sector luminaries, industry thought-leaders, academics, governmental bodies, professional associations, and others to build and grow a global, multi-stakeholder cybersecurity ecosystem.
